

CROWTHORNE AND SANDHURST ART SOCIETY 2018

Rules for exhibiting at any society art exhibitions

- 1 Framed pictures will be charged at £1.50 each.
- 2 Portfolio pictures will be charged at 50p each.
- 3 **All sales of any of the above will be subject to a deduction of 15% commission for the society.**
- 4 Cards will be entered free of charge.
- 5 **All sales of Cards will remain subject to a deduction of 10% commission.**
- 6 All framed pictures must have a tie-on label attached with the following information clearly printed on.
Artist's name
Title of picture
Medium
Price
If your picture is sold this label will be removed as proof of sale.
- 7 Portfolio pictures must have a stiff backing board, be mounted if appropriate, and covered in clear acetate/cellophane.
- 8 Portfolio pictures must have a self adhesive label attached to the top right hand corner on the front with the same information as framed pictures.
- 9 A minimum price of £25 per portfolio picture will be applied.
- 10 In the annual October exhibition no framed picture can be shown that was entered in a previous October exhibition. This rule does not apply to the Spring (April) exhibition.
- 11 In the Spring exhibition a spare picture can be submitted at no charge which may be used if there is exhibition space created by pictures being sold and removed.
- 12 Although maximum care will be taken at all times Crowthorne and Sandhurst Art Society cannot accept responsibility for any loss or damage to any exhibit from any cause whatsoever.
- 13 Cards must be the original painting, print or photograph of the original painting and must be the members own work. Cards made from mass produced card kits will not be permitted.
- 14 All cards must be suitably presented in a professional manner preferably with acetate covers, envelopes etc. with a small price tag attached with your initial and price.
- 15 A maximum of 50 cards per member.

All pictures must be suitably mounted and framed in a manner that befits a quality product suitable for purchase.

No picture will be accepted with framing wire, clip frames, photo frames with attached rear stand, damaged frames, glass or buckled frames.

D rings are preferable although screw eyes will still be accepted provided they are secure and not considered a problem by the booking-in officers.

Hanging cord is preferred but please ensure that any knot is not in the centre of the hanging loop, (it gets in the way of the suspension hook)

Check that the picture hangs correctly, that is that it does not hang at a large angle to the wall, and that the hanging cord is hidden behind the painting.

The backing board must be secure and not buckled. 2mm MDF is preferred.

The booking-in officers have the right to refuse acceptance of any picture that, in their opinion, does not conform to the high standard of the society.
